



DARMASISWA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

INTRODUCTION OF DARMASISWA

DARMASISWA is a scholarship program offered to all foreign students from countries which have diplomatic relationship with Indonesia to study Indonesian language (Bahasa Indonesia), art and culture in 71 universities in 2019. This program was established in 1974 as part of ASEAN initiative, admitting only students from ASEAN. However, in 1974 this program was extended further to other countries. Until to date, the number of countries participating in this program is more than 126 countries organized by the Ministry of Education and Culture (MoEC), Republic of Indonesia.

The main purpose of DARMASISWA RI program is to promote and increase the interest in the language, art and culture of Indonesia among youth of other countries. It has also been designed to provide stronger cultural links and understanding among participating countries

I. PROCEDURE

Prospective students are required to register and submit all documents in Darmasiswa RI official website apply.darmasiswa.kemdikbud.go.id. For students who are not in the student's home country is not allowed to be registered through the Indonesian Embassy/Consulate General in the participating countries (non-citizenship).

II. PROGRAM SCHEDULE

- Online Registration (1 January until 1 March 2019)
- Interview at related KBR/KJRI (4 March 2019 until 15 March 2019)
- Selection by the University (online) (18 March 2019 until 3 April 2019)
- Announcement (10 April 2019)
- Attendance confirmation (10 April 2019 until 30 April 2019)
- Final Announcement (6 May 2019)
- Flight itinerary confirmation (7 May 2019 until 1 August 2019)
- Arrival at Jakarta, Indonesia (28 August 2019)
- Orientation program at Jakarta, Indonesia (29 until 30 August 2019)

III. COVERAGE OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. Students monthly stipend will be divided into 2 groups of area:
1st area Rp. 2.950.000,- (DKI Jakarta, Batam, Bandung, Surabaya, Bali, Manado, Makassar & Ambon)
2nd area Rp. 2.550.000,- (Aceh, Medan, Padang, Palembang, Lampung, Bogor, Purwokerto, Semarang, Yogyakarta, Surakarta, Malang & Samarinda).
2. Students will be provided with accommodation and transportation during the Orientation Program if the time arrival in time with the schedule from the Ministry of Education and Culture.
3. Students will get settlement allowance if they attend the Orientation Program.
4. Students legal permit arrangement will be supported by the Host University and Ministry of Education and Culture.
5. Students may seek assistance from Host University in finding a house/room to rent which is included in monthly the stipend.

IV. QUALIFICATIONS

1. Preferably Student.
2. Completed secondary education or its equivalent.
3. Minimum age 17 years and Not older than 35 years of age.
4. Unmarried.
5. Able to communicate in English and additional Bahasa Indonesia (Proven by English Language Proficiency Certificate : TOEFL/TOEIC/IELTS or OTHER CERTIFICATE if applicable).
6. In good health as proved by Medical Certificate.
7. Have basic knowledge of the field you're applying.

V. INTERNATIONAL AIRFARE TICKET

The Ministry of Education and Culture does not provide the International airfare to/from Indonesia.

VI. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

1. Curriculum vitae/resume.
2. Medical Certificate.
3. Passport valid at least 18 months from time of arrival in Indonesia (estimated arrival : 1st August 2019).
4. Recommendation Letter From Education Institution / Professional Institution on official letterhead and signature (In English).
5. Last academic transcript and certificates (in English).
6. Language certificate (if applicable).
7. Other certificates that related to the field you're applying (if applicable).
8. Essay about the purpose of study (In english or bahasa Indonesia maximum 500 words).

VII. HEALTH INSURANCE

Will be receiving a local health insurance provided by BNI Life Insurance in collaboration with MoEC.
